



## **CONTEÚDOS PROGRAMÁTICOS:**

### **I – PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION**

1. Topic areas: name; first name; surname; address; telephone number; age; origin; nationality; date and place of birth; job and occupation; place of work; ask and answer about possessions (have got);
2. Language focus: verb to be; possessive adjectives; interrogative pronouns, prepositions of place; plural forms; possessive case; possessive pronouns; affirmative, negative, and interrogative sentences.

### **II – DESCRIBING ACTIONS / ACTIVITIES**

1. Topic areas: routines; everyday actions; ask and say the time; time expressions; describing people;
2. Language focus: present simple and present continuous; adverbs of frequency with the verb "to be" and with other verbs; degrees of the adjectives (comparatives and superlatives).

### **III – MY WORLD**

1. Topic areas: getting to know each other; interviewing; describing pictures;
2. Language focus: past simple and past continuous.

### **IV – A WORLD OF MANY LANGUAGES**

1. Topic areas: The triumph of English; the future of English; European youth exchange;
2. Language focus: present perfect and present perfect continuous; British and American English; prepositional verbs, definite article, indefinite article and zero article; adverbs of manner; past perfect simple and past perfect continuous; conditionals (types 0, 1, 2, and 3).

### **V – YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE GLOBAL ERA**

1. Topic areas: career information; the job of your dreams; applying for a job; job interview;
2. Language focus: the future (will + infinitive; 'be going to'); modal verbs; quantifiers.
