INSURANCE VISA	It's mandatory for all students to have a personal health insurance, available in Portugal. Students from EU countries should obtain the European Health Insurance Card in their country of origin prior to their arrival. The European Health Insurance Card gives access to the portuguese public health system (National Health Service). VISA applications: Citizens from non-EU countries must contact, in advance, the appropriate authorities in their home country regarding the process for obtaining a VISA or residence permit in Portugal.
